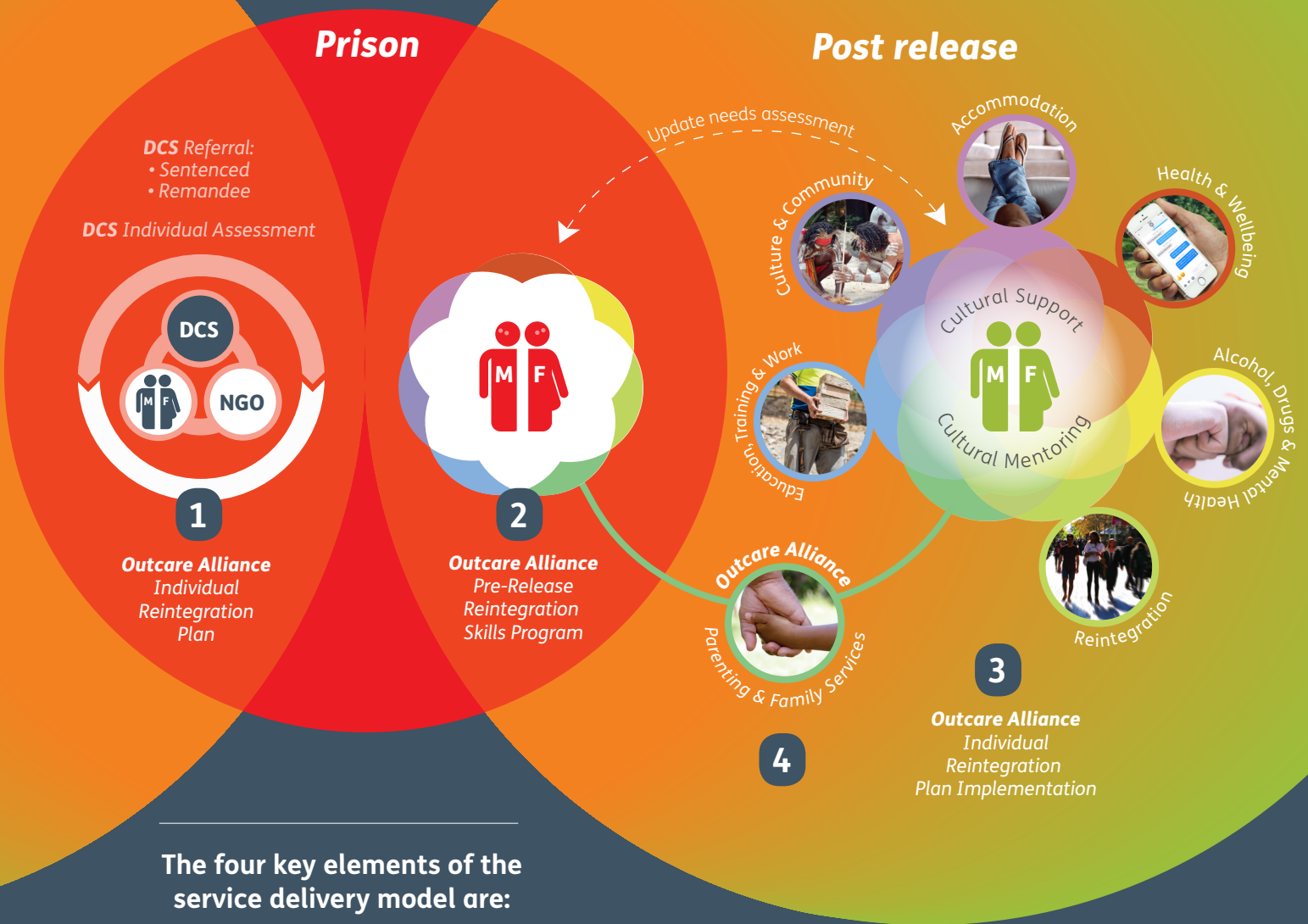


Reintegration Services


Methodology & Approach



The four key elements of the service delivery model are:

1. Needs Assessment & Reintegration Planning
2. Pre-release Reintegration Skills Program
3. Throughcare and Reintegration Plan Implementation
4. Parenting and Family Services

<p>Employment & Training</p> <p>Offenders have increased access to meaningful and stable engagement in employment, education, training or other vocational activities within the community.</p>	<p>Health & Wellbeing</p> <p>Offenders have increased understanding and awareness of how to maintain good health and physical wellbeing.</p>	<p>Housing Accommodation</p> <p>Offenders have improved access to suitable and sustainable housing.</p>	<p>Reintegration Practical Skills</p> <p>Offenders have support and service for successful reintegration into the community.</p>
	<p>Parenting & Family Support Relationships</p> <p>Offenders experience improved family relationships and personal networks.</p>	<p>AOD & Mental Health</p> <p>Offenders have opportunities to address AOD issues through provision of brief intervention, throughcare and maintenance service.</p>	<p>Cultural & Community Connections</p> <p>Offenders experience support and opportunities to reconnect with their communities and culture.</p>
